Victims of double homicide remembered

DAYTON, Ohio (WDTN) — A homicide vigil remembers two lives lost to gun violence.

Folks gathered Saturday afternoon at the corner of Brooklyn and Fairbanks avenues to pray for

21-year-old Damionna Goodall and 22-year-old DeAndre Crane.

The two were killed after being shot in the 600 block of Brooklyn Avenue January 29. Crane died at the scene. Goodall died at the hospital.

A third victim, 20-year-old Dashawn Robinson, remains in critical condition in the hospital.

Saturday's vigil was led by the Sisters of the Precious Blood. The vigil was also a chance for family and friends to pray for Robinson's recovery.
